What is a Fiscal Sponsor?

A fiscal sponsor is a nonprofit organization that provides fiduciary oversight, financial management, and other administrative services to help build the capacity of charitable projects.

Why might fiscal sponsorship be right for you?

Fiscal sponsorships provide immediate access to tax deductible donations, grants and mature organizational services. These things are particularly helpful for a season to build internal capacity. Ultimately, fiscal sponsorship is not intended to be a long-term solution.
